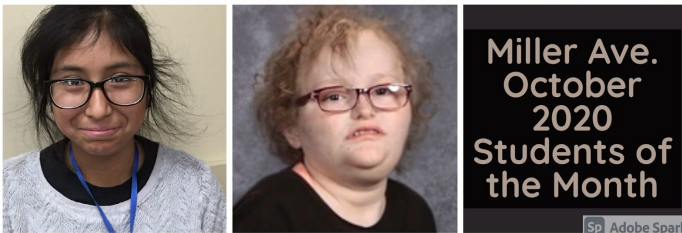

If your child will need to have any medication administered during school hours the parent/guardian may come to the school to administer it. If the medication must be administered by the school Secretary or Nurse, the proper paperwork must be filled out by the physician and sent into the school. **PLEASE do not send** in cough drops and such with your child.

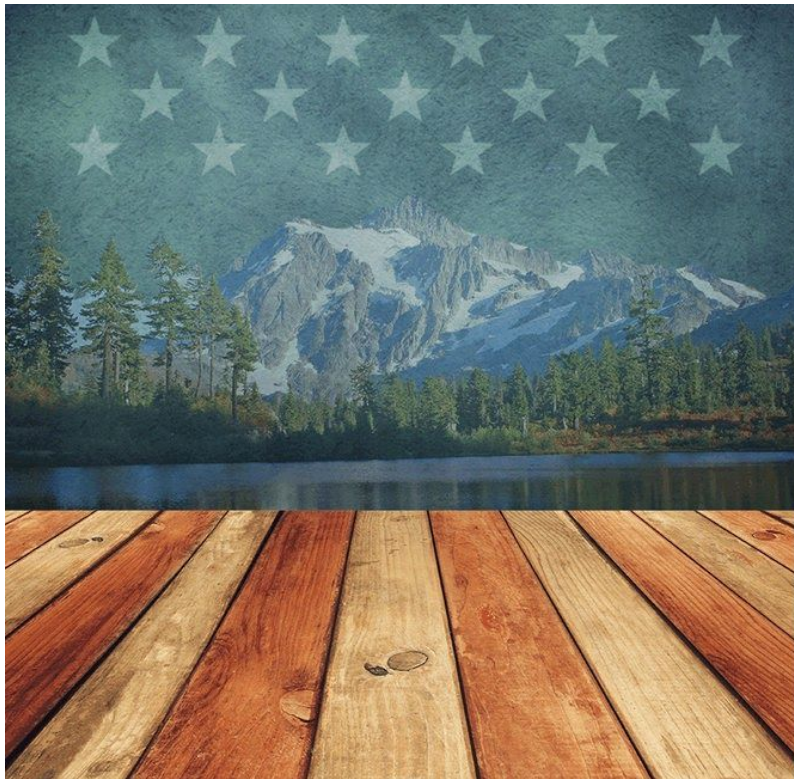
THE 2019-2020 YEARBOOKS ARE HERE!!

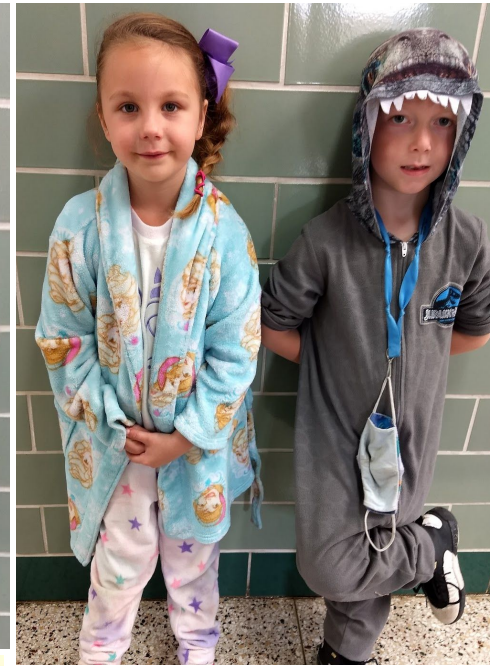
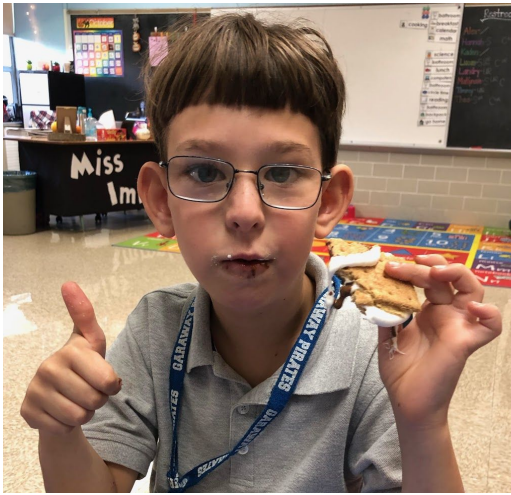


A NOTE FROM THE CAFETERIA: Please **DO NOT** send in any food in packed lunches that will need to be refrigerated and/or microwaved.

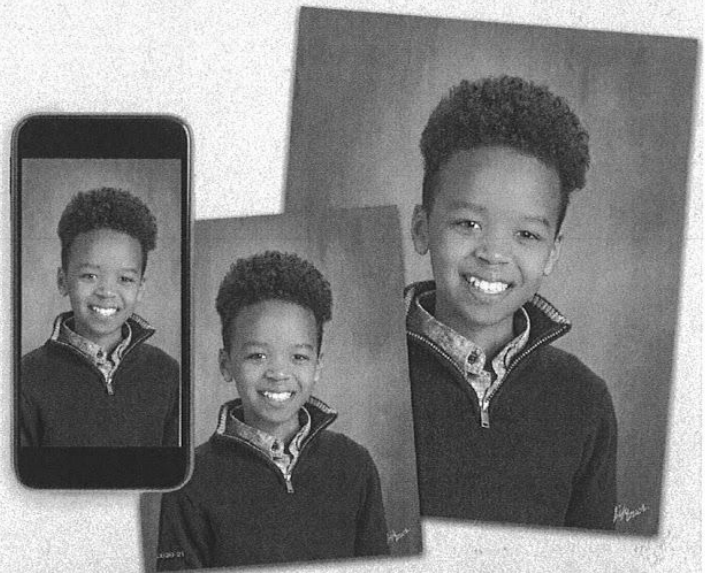

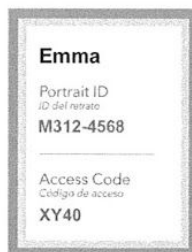
