

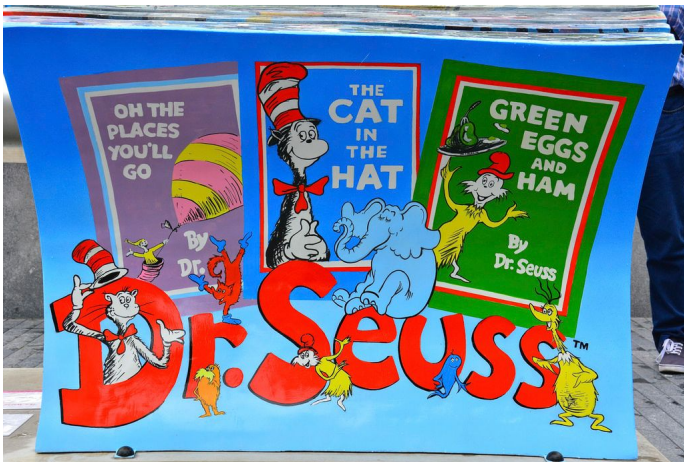

Kindergarten registration for all Garaway elementary schools (Baltic, Ragersville, Miller Avenue and Dundee) will be held **Tuesday, March 19th through Friday, March 22nd** between **10:00-11:00 a.m. and 12:30-3:00 p.m.** in each elementary school office. Your child must be 5 years old before August 1st, 2019 to register. Parents need to register at the home school of their kindergartener and come prepared with the child's social security card, birth certificate, immunization record and custody papers, if applicable. Screening times will also be signed up for at the time of registration. **The screening dates for this year will be Thursday, April 26th and Friday, April 27th and will take place at the Belden Center.**

We strongly encourage parents only at registration as students are not required to attend registration.

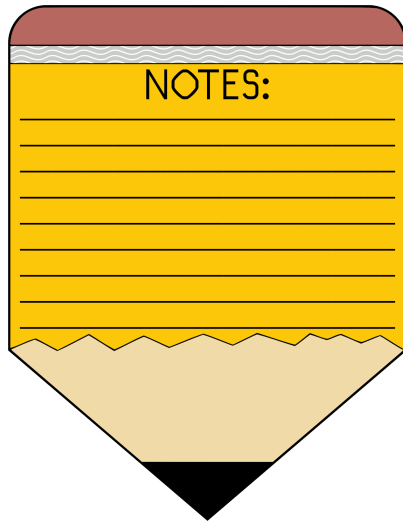

Free Health Care Weekend care GuardCare

When: Saturday, August 10th & Sunday, August 11th, 2019

Where: Buckeye Career Center, 545 University Drive NE, New Philadelphia

What: GuardCare is completely FREE health care event offering basic primary care services like physicals, blood work-ups, screenings, vaccinations.

Who: anyone can come to the event - no restrictions, all services are 100% free. Nothing is billed to the patient or insurance,

Why: The event is a partnership of the Tuscarawas County Health Department, Ohio National Guard and the Ohio Department of Health. The Ohio National Guard provides GuardCare once a year. The event is a test of the Ohio National Guard's medical units' ability to respond if there was a need for mass medical services within a community.



****When sending in money to the school for such things as lunches, camp and chromebook fees, please make the check payable to Garaway Local Schools and include in the memo line what the money is for - PLEASE DO NOT make it out to Miller Ave. as the bank will not accept it. *Thank you!!***

A NOTE FROM THE CAFETERIA: Please **DO NOT** send in any food in packed lunches that will need to be refrigerated and/or microwaved. Also milk may be purchased with a packed lunch - it is 50 cents for each milk and the child must report to the teacher on duty that they would like to purchase the milk so that his/her account will be charged accordingly. Students who are on a Free/Reduced status will also be charged if purchasing a milk with their packed lunch as that status is only for school lunch purchases.
