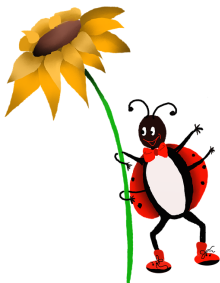

The Challenge

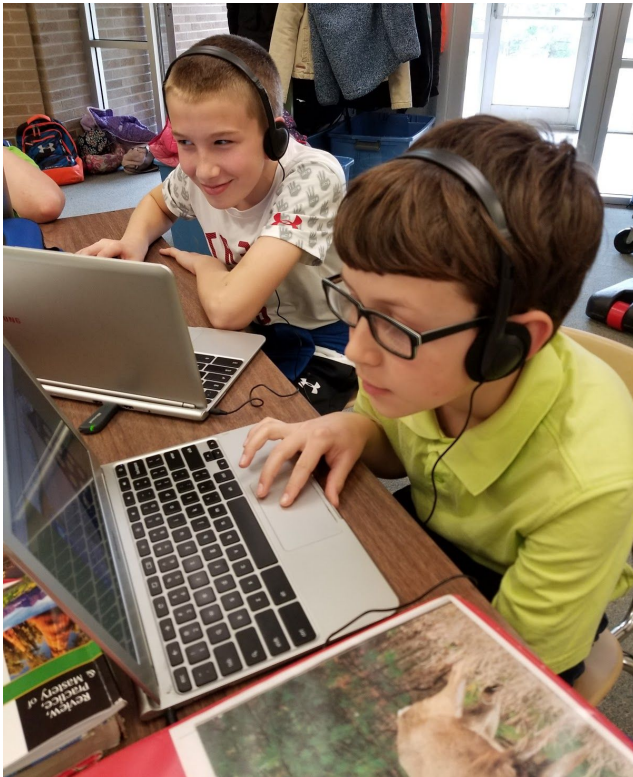
- Each class will have a collection jar by the office windows.

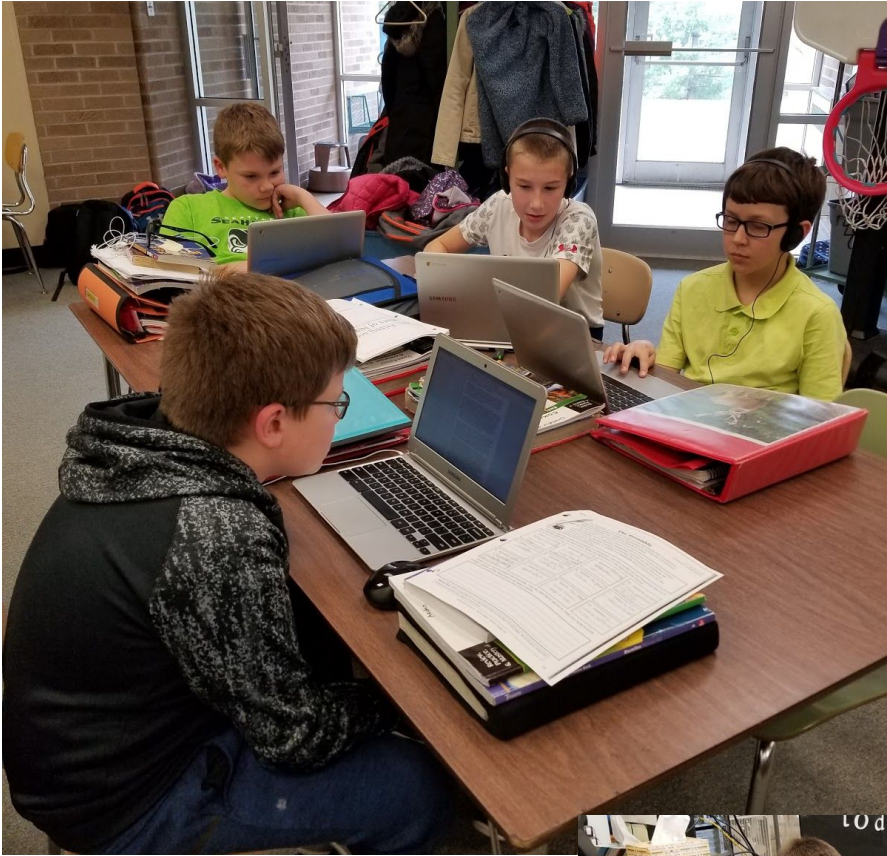
