General Information Important to All Students

1. Grades 7 through 12: Your exam results will not affect your grades for the nine-week grading period. They do, however, have a bearing on your semester average and your cumulative grade point average. The exam represents 1/5 of your semester grade.
2. All exam periods are one hour in length. Each teacher in all subjects will have an exam/test. Students must remain in the testing rooms quietly until the end of the exam period. If you finish your test early, study for the next test or bring some reading materials.
3. Attendance will be taken each period and announcements will be emailed.
4. If you do not have a test the first testing period, you don't have to come in until the second testing period on any of the days.
5. *Students are not permitted to leave the building during the exam periods.*
6. Students with unexcused absences will be truant and not permitted to make up the semester exams.

7. It is highly recommended that students going on vacation make arrangements to take exams before they leave.
8. Lunch will be served in the cafeteria from 11:23-12:11. A sack lunch will be available to all students. There are no changes to how you pay for your lunch on exam days. In fact, you can get your sack lunch after your last exam and take it home with you!
9. After a student's last exam period of the day, the student is dismissed. They will sign out in the classroom of their last exam. **** If you, as a parent/guardian want your student to remain at school and not leave after their last exam, please call 330.852.4292 and tell Mrs. O'Farrell.**
10. Students arriving late or leaving early will need to have their own transportation to and from school.
11. If there is a snow day, exams will move to the next school day and possibly after Christmas break.
