## Dewey H. and Irene G. Moomaw Scholarship

## **Guidelines**

This is a renewable scholarship created to encourage and assist qualified Garaway High School students to attend programs of higher education. The scholarship amount will be \$4,000 annually and will be renewable over four (4) years.

### **History of Moomaw family:**

Dewey and Irene Moomaw were life residents of Sugarcreek and graduates of Sugarcreek-Shanesville High School. Irene was a graduate of beauty school and had her own beauty shop in Sugarcreek for 50 years. She was also a member of the Sugarcreek Lioness club. Dewey worked in the family business Shepfer & Moomaw Bros. Brick and upon the death of the founder became the vice-president. He held that position until the company was sold to Belden Brick. He was a charter member of the Sugarcreek Lions club and was a member of the board of directors for the Reeves and Huntington Bank.

Both were members of the Shanesville Lutheran Church where Irene sang in the choir and Dewey was a member of the dart ball team.

## **Application Process**

Applications will be made available each year through the Garaway High School guidance office. Deadline to submit application for seniors is March 30 to the Garaway Central Office. Upon receipt of the student's application, the Dewey H. and Irene Moomaw scholarship committee will review applications. An interview with the applicant may be requested if deemed necessary.

## **Requirements**

- 1. Minimum GPA 2.5. Must provide transcript.
- 2. Must provide a complete application.
- 3. Must provide a resume of school/non-school activities.
- 4. Must be accepted to and plan to attend a 4-year accredited school of higher education.
- 5. Must provide one recommendation, not school related.

### **Selection Process**

The decision of the Scholarship Committee is final and will be based on:

- 1. Completed application and written requirements.
- 2. Financial need (proof of financial need may be required).
- 3. High School leadership roles, community service, athletic and extra-curricular activities.

## **Renewable Process**

Renewable applications will be mailed to applicants in January of each year.

- 1. Must maintain an accumulative college GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- 2. Must reapply by March 1.
- 3. Renewable scholarship amounts will be determined on a yearly basis.
