Resolution Determining to Submit to the Electors of the School District the Question
of an additional Tax Levy Pursuant to Section 5705.194 to 5705.197 of the Revised
Code in the amount of \$1,003,982.

The Board of Education of the Garaway Local School District met in regular session on December 17, 2018, commencing at 6:00 p.m., in the High School Library, 146 Dover Road N.W., Sugarcreek, Ohio, with the following members present:

The Treasurer advised the Board that the notice requirements of Section 121.22 of the Revised Code and the implementing rules adopted by the Board pursuant thereto were complied with for the meeting.

Mss. Many Psysi moved the adoption of the following resolution:

A RESOLUTION DETERMINING TO SUBMIT TO THE ELECTORS OF THE GARAWAY LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT THE QUESTION OF AN ADDITIONAL TAX LEVY, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 5705.194 TO 5705.197 OF THE REVISED CODE.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 5705.194 of the Revised Code and Division (B) of Section 5705.03 of the Revised Code, when this Board determines that it is necessary to levy a tax outside the ten-mill limitation to provide for the emergency requirements of this School District, this Board is required to certify to the County Auditor a resolution requesting the County Auditor to certify to it the total current tax valuation of the School District and the number of mills required to generate a specified amount of revenue; and

WHEREAS, upon receipt of a certified copy of such a resolution of this Board declaring the necessity of a tax, stating its purpose, whether it is an additional levy, a renewal or a replacement of an existing tax, or the renewal or replacement of an existing tax with an increase or a decrease, the Section or Sections of the Revised Code authorizing the submission of the question of the tax, the term of years of the tax, that the tax is to be levied upon the entire territory of the School District, the date of the election at which the question of the tax shall appear on the ballot, that the ballot measure shall be submitted to the entire territory of the School District, the tax year in which the tax will first be levied and the calendar year in which it will be first collected and each county in which the School District has territory, and requesting such certifytothis Board within not more than 10 days both the total current tax valuation of the School District and the number of mills required to generate the specified amount of revenue;

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Garaway Local School District, Tuscarawas, Coshocton and Holmes Counties, Ohio, that:

Section 1. This Board finds, determines and declares that the revenue that will be raised by all tax levies which this School District is authorized to impose, when combined with state and federal revenues available to this Board, will be insufficient to provide for the emergency requirements of this School District, and that it is therefore necessary to levy an additional tax in

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excess of the ten-mill limitation upon the entire territory of the School District in order to raise the amount of \$1,003,982 each calendar year for a period of ten years for that purpose.

Section 2. Pursuant to Sections 5705.194 through 5705.197 of the Revised Code, there shall be submitted to the electors of the entire territory of this School District (which includes territory in Tuscarawas, Coshocton and Holmes Counties), at an election to be held on May 7, 2019, the question of an additional tax levy in excess of the ten-mill limitation on all property in the entire territory of the School District subject to taxation by this Board in order to raise the amount of \$1,003,982 each calendar year for a period of ten years (commencing with a levy on the tax list and duplicate for the year 2019 for first collection and distribution to the School District in calendar year 2020) for the purpose of providing for the emergency requirements of this School District, at the annual tax rate necessary to raise that amount.

Section 3. The Treasurer is directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Tuscarawas County Auditor immediately, and that County Auditor is requested to certify to this Board both the School District's total current tax valuation and his calculation of the annual levy, expressed in dollars and cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, as well as in mills for each one dollar of valuation, throughout the life of the levy which will be required to produce the annual amount set forth above, which calculation shall be made in accordance with the requirements of Section 5705.195 of the Revised Code and any applicable rules, orders, or instructions of the State Tax Commissioner.

Section 4. This Board finds and determines that all formal actions of this Board and of any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were taken, and that all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were held, in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 5. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its adoption.
