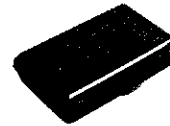

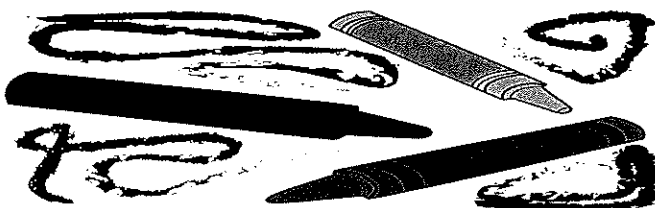

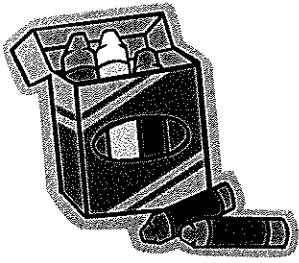

Each student should have the following list of supplies for the beginning of the school year:

- 2 boxes of Crayola Crayons (24 count only)
- 1 pair scissors
- 8 Elmer's glue sticks
- 1 4oz. bottle of Elmer's glue (this will go to the art room)
- 2 pink block erasers
- 1 plastic art box (small size to fit in desk)
- 1 1-inch, three ring binder (*hard cover)

Optional for classroom **donation**, for all students to use throughout the year:

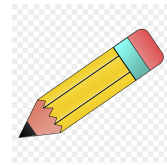
(Please do not put your child's initials/name on these items)

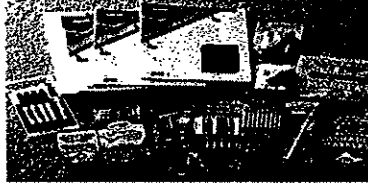

School Supply List for 4th, 5th, and 6th Grades 2023-2024 School Year

- **Wide loose leaf paper to be kept in a binder.** This may need to be replaced throughout the year.
- **A composition notebook for Language Arts.** Returning 6th graders may use theirs from last year.
- **1 - 1 subject wide ruled spiral bound notebooks (Social Studies / Science)**
- **Pencils and erasers.** If you send in mechanical pencils, please supply lead.
- **2 ink pens**
- **2 yellow highlighters**
- **Headphones for Chromebooks.** The cheaper ones tend to break easily and will need to be replaced if that happens.
- **Mouse for Chromebook (highly recommend).** Extra batteries to be kept on hand when they need replaced.
- **Scientific calculator (5th & 6th Grade ONLY)** The TI-30 is what is used in middle school.
- **3 boxes of tissues**
- **1 roll of paper towels (4th Grade ONLY)**
- **Crayons, color pencils, glue, and scissors.** These can be stored in a small art box, in a zip pouch, or in a ziplock bag.

For art class, each grade is assigned one supply which will be kept in the art room.

- **4th grade: 1 tray of Crayola Watercolor Paints**
- **5th grade: 1 package Crayola Classic Color Markers, 10 count**
- **6th grade: 1 package oil pastels, 16 count**
