(Please do not put your child's initials/name on these items)

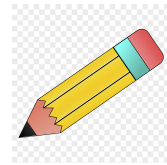
- 12-pack Ticonderoga Laddie Pencils (with erasers) *Note these are larger than regular pencils.

School Supply List for 4th, 5th, and 6th Grades 2024-2025 School Year

- 2 inch 3 ring zipper binder
- Wide loose leaf paper to be kept in a binder. This may need to be replaced throughout the year.
- 1 composition notebook for Language Arts. Returning 5th & 6th graders may use theirs from last year.
- 3 - 1 subject wide ruled spiral bound notebooks {Social Studies, Science & Math}
- Pencils and erasers + pencil pouch *If you send in mechanical pencils, please supply lead.
- 2 ink pens
- 2 highlighters
- Headphones for Chromebooks The cheaper ones tend to break easily and will need to be replaced if that happens.
- Mouse for Chromebook (highly recommend). Extra batteries to be kept on hand when they need replaced.
- Scientific calculator (5th & 6th Grade ONLY) The TI-30 is what is used in middle school.
- 3 boxes of tissues
- 1 roll of paper towels (4th Grade ONLY)
- Crayons, colored pencils, glue, and scissors. {store in a small art box, zip pouch, or ziplock bag}

For art class, each grade is assigned one supply which will be kept in the art room.

- 1 package Crayola Classic Color Broad Tip Markers, 10 count
