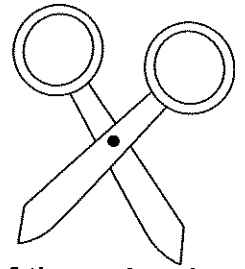

Each student should have the following list of supplies for the beginning of the school year: **Please bring these things to open house or to the KRA appointment.**

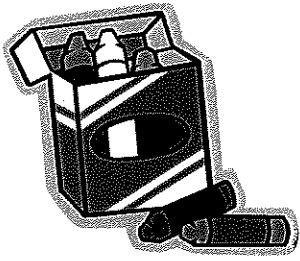
- 2 boxes of Crayola Crayons (24 count only)
- 1 pair of scissors
- 12 Elmer's glue sticks
- 6 pencils
- 2 pink block erasers
- 1 spiral notebook (wide-ruled)
- 1 10 X 12 pocket folder
- 4 pack Expo dry-erase markers
- Sturdy/Durable headphones-please no ear buds
- 1 large box of tissues for classroom use
- Backpack that is large enough to carry home a 10 X 12 folder
- 1 container Clorox or Lysol disinfecting wipes
- 1 art box (16 X 8 is usually a good size)

Girls – paper towels

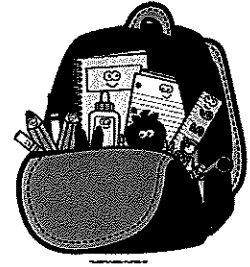
Boys – Zip-Loc baggies – quart or gallon size

- ★ 1 wide-ruled composition notebook (Language Arts)
 - ★ 1 - 1 subject wide ruled spiral bound notebook
 - ★ 4 pocket folders (prefer different colors)
 - ★ Post-it flags (available at Staples)
 - ★ Pencil pouch
 - ★ 6 - #2 Pencils (NO mechanical pencils)
 - ★ 2 ink pens - any color
 - ★ 3 highlighters - any color
 - ★ Erasers (large and pencil cap)
 - ★ Ruler (inches AND centimeters)
 - ★ Protractor
 - ★ Headphones (earbuds)
 - ★ Mouse / Wireless Mouse (highly encouraged)
 - ★ Art Supplies for classroom use: crayons, colored pencils, markers, scissors, 2 glue sticks or Elmer's liquid glue (NO ART BOX NEEDED)
 - ★ Kleenex - 1 - 2 boxes (they go fast due to colds/allergies)

School Supply List for 5th and 6th grades 2022-2023 School year

1. Loose-leaf paper kept in a binder and for work/scrap paper for math. This may need to be replaced throughout the year.
2. Two boxes of tissues
3. Paper towels, 5th: one roll, 6th: two rolls
4. A composition notebook for Language Arts
5. A folder with 3 holes to be kept in a binder for Mrs. Powell's classes
6. A section in their binder for Math and one for Science
7. Pencils and erasers. Pencil topper erasers seem the most popular. Students need more of these as the year goes on. If you send in mechanical pencils, please supply lead.
8. 2 ink pens
9. Yellow highlighters
10. Headphones for Chromebooks- the cheaper ones tend to break easily, and will need to be replaced throughout the year if that happens.
11. Mouse if your student uses one
12. Scientific calculator for both 5th and 6th grade for Math and Science (the TI-30 is used in Middle School). Be sure to put your name on it in permanent marker.
13. Crayons
14. Colored Pencils
15. Smaller Glue
16. Scissors

For art class, students are assigned to bring in one supply which will be kept in the art room.
