The condition of the parking lots surrounding the high school building is also of concern, The Committee approved two projects to go forward: the grading of the outside perimeter of elementary school buildings to prevent water infiltration and the replacement of deteriorated screws on the High School gym roof to help extend the life the roof and prevent damage to the gym floor at a cost of approximately \$7,000.
