- A. I recommend approval of the resolution for career technical education (CTE) middle school courses waiver for Garaway 7-12 School.

Rationale The Garaway Board of Education wishes to waive career-technical education middle grades requirements for the 2015-2016 school year.

WHEREAS, Garaway 7-12 School is a Garaway Board of Education governed school, NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Garaway Board of Education waive the career-technical education (CTE) middle school course requirements for Garaway 7-12 school for the entire 2015-2016 school year.
